






About Moosehead CEDAR LOG HOMES







WHY CEDAR:

Cedar is one of the highest quality, structurally stable and durable woods used in today's log home construction. Durability attained from natural preservatives in the wood that repel insects, along with a closed cellular structure that inhibit mold and decay. The stability of our cedar is a result of our air drying process that balances moisture content, minimizing and warping or shrinking.

Our cedar log homes are roughly 15-20% more energy efficient than a standard "stick-built" home. Efficiency is achieved through our non-settling system that provides 4 points of protection from airflow and drafting:

1. Perfect fit milling

- 3. "Log Hog" securing
- 2. Double tongue and groove
- 4. Foam & caulk sealed courses

**Increased energy efficiency can be achieved by utilizing one of our optional Insulation Packages. This allows you to determine the level of energy efficiency your log home will provide, based on your individual needs.



The Rangeley model is ideal for creating a casual retreat away from it all. Perfect for a vacation home or a year round abode. This mid-size model has the versatility to do it all.




